## **Restaurant of the Week features Lety's Authentic Mexican Restaurant**

Lety's Authentic Mexican Restaurant is based on a strong restaurant background, delicious family recipes, and a good work ethic. Lety's is the featured restaurant this week in the Downtown Restaurant of the Week promotion. During the week of March 1-7, the spotlight will focus on Lety's for the Downtown workforce and throughout the wider community. Each week, a new Downtown restaurant is featured.

Raul Salgado opened restaurants across the country for a major chain for many years, but that meant moving his family around the country. When they decided to settle down, they picked Fresno, and opened the first Lety's (named after Raul's wife) on Clinton and Chestnut. They opened the Downtown Lety's in July, 2008, because of a love of Downtowns from their travels. It features the same authentic homemade sauces and native Guerrero Mexican-style recipes as the first Lety's.

Besides the great food, Lety's offers a variety of customer-pleasing amenities. Wi-fi access is available, as is a great jukebox with a wide variety of English and Spanish music choices. Coming soon are entertainment evenings with live feeds of sporting and entertainment events and a new website. In the family tradition, daughter Jeraldine Salgado is looking forward to taking over management of the Downtown Lety's.

Getting back to the great food, Lety's offers daily \$5 breakfast and lunch specials. They also offer fresh hot soup, including cocido and menudo, every day, all day long. All sauces and soups are made from scratch daily.

Lety's Authentic Mexican Restaurant is located at 915 Van Ness Avenue between Tulare and Kern Streets. They are open from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm Monday through Friday (9:00 am on Tuesdays), and from 10:00 am to 5:00 pm on Saturday and Sunday. Look for evening hours as the season changes.

If you're not walking to Lety's, the best place to park is in the spiral garage at Van Ness and Inyo, for which Lety's offers parking validation.
